Lafayette County School District wants your artwork for the upcoming “Art in the Capitol” visual arts competition. This includes 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students attending the Lafayette County public school, the private school and home schools. The artwork will be judged by a selection committee. One (1) student’s artwork will be selected as the winner for our school district and will be provided to Senator Rob Bradley, Senator for Lafayette County. The winning submissions from each district will be displayed in the Capitol Building during the upcoming regular legislative session.

The Artwork Parameters are:

- All artwork submitted must be two-dimensional.
- All work submitted must weigh less than 15 pounds and not exceed 28’ x 28” x 4”.
- All work submitted must be original in concept, design and execution.
- All work submitted must not violate any copyright laws.
- All work submitted must include student’s name, grade, school and city in which the school is located.

All artwork must be submitted to Gina Hart at the Lafayette County School Board office by October 10, 2017.
